

Hashima Safety Pledge

I hereby announce that I will abide by the Hashima Safety Pledge during my visit on Hashima (Gunkanjima) Island.

1. Areas outside of the designated pathways and observation decks are off-limits. Do not trespass.
2. Do not :
 - climb fences, run or disobey the guides' instructions. - drink alcohol or smoke tobacco.
 - spoil the facilities and leave any garbage on the island. - use umbrellas.
 - bother or harass other guests during the tour. - use open flames or any incendiary objects.
 - hang banners, conduct protests, or any other civil unrest.
3. Always follow the Concierge staff guidance at all times.
4. Wear shoes and clothes suitable for safe passage and landing on the island.
5. Small children and persons with disabilities need to be accompanied. Please contact the Concierge office before coming.

Anyone entering the restricted area of Hashima will be photographed, and have their photograph given to the police as evidence of trespassing.

I also announce that I have read and fully understood the following:

- Depending on weather and sea conditions the landing on Hashima (Gunkanjima) Island might not be possible. With safety as the first and foremost priority, the final decision about the possibility of landing will be determined by the Captain upon getting close to the island. In case landing on Hashima is not possible, we will refund you the admission to the island and give you our complimentary goods after the tour.
- The audio tours are a free service, so we don't offer refunds if there are problems with the audio guide tour.
- Depending on the weather and sea conditions, there might be sea spray on the upper deck seats.
On extreme occasions, the upper deck might be off-limits to the guests.
- To protect the copyright laws on intellectual property, it is forbidden to record the guide's explanations or videos shown on the ship for extended periods of time.
- As observation areas and pathways between them are narrow, it is forbidden to use any kind of umbrellas on the tour, especially while visiting Hashima (Gunkanjima) Island.
- While it is allowed to record audio and video during the tour, uploading recordings of guides' explanations is

- This is a UNESCO site. Playing Pokemon Go or any other video games/smartphone games is highly disrespectful and strictly prohibited.
